



Dear IHS Member,

Elections for the IHS Board of Trustees will be held prior to the IHC in Vancouver, Canada, in September 2017.

Following the AGM in Vancouver, Professor David Dodick will step down, Professor Lars Edvinsson will assume the role of President, and a new President-elect will join the Board.

Two candidates have been selected by the Leadership, Development and Nominations Committee to stand for President-elect, and a member ballot will be held to appoint the President-elect and Elected Trustees prior to the AGM.

Three of the current Elected Trustees are eligible and willing to remain on the Board:

Anna Ambrosini

Rigmor Jensen

Gisela Terwindt

and do not require re-election.

There are three vacant positions.

The nominee must be a Standard Member when nominated. Nominations should be proposed by a Standard Member and seconded by a different Standard Member, and supported by a personal written statement by the nominee including a written indication of intention to stand for election as a Trustee.

Standard Members may propose or second only one person to stand for election as a Trustee.

Nominations should be drawn from as broad a group as possible, representing the latest research and knowledge in the field and ensuring geographical diversity.

An Elected Trustee shall serve for a term of 2 years, and is eligible to remain on the Board for a further 2-year term without need for re-election (total 4 years).

Trustees are expected to attend at least two Board meetings per year, one in connection with IHC or the Migraine Trust Symposium. Usually there will be three/four meetings per year, although these are often held by teleconference.

Every Trustee must sign a declaration of willingness to act as a Trustee of the Charity before he or she may vote at any meeting of the Trustees.

Interested candidates should return the form and submit background information, including activities related to the goals of IHS and their reasons for wishing to serve as a Trustee, and any relevant Disclosures.
